It is ordered that Rule 72(a), W.R.C.P., be amended to read as follows:

(a) "Final Order" Defined. A final order is: (1) an order affecting a substantial right in an action, when such order in effect determines the action and prevents a judgment; (2) an order affecting a substantial right, made in a special proceeding, or upon a summary application in an action, after judgment; (3) an order, including a conditional order, granting a new trial on the grounds stated in Rule 59(a)(4) and (5)--if an appeal is taken from such an order, the judgment shall remain final and in effect for the purposes of appeal by another party.

It is further ordered that this order be published in the Wyoming Reporter and that this amendment shall become effective ninety days after publication in the Pacific Reporter, Second Series, Advance Sheets.
