**ORDER REINSTATING RULE 40.1(b)(1) OF THE WYOMING RULES OF CIVIL PROCEDURE AND
REINSTATING RULE 21.1(a) OF THE WYOMING RULES OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE PROVIDING
FOR CHANGE OF JUDGE, PEREMPTORY DISQUALIFICATION**

THIS COURT having fully considered the report and recommendation of the Permanent Rules Advisory Committee for Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure finds that Rule 40.1(b)(1) of Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure providing for change of judge, peremptory disqualification, be reinstated as written prior to suspension on March 16, 1998.

THIS COURT having also fully considered the recommendation of the Permanent Rules Advisory Committee for Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure finds that Rule 21.1(a) of Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure which provides for change of judge, peremptory disqualification, be reinstated as written prior to suspension on March 16, 1998. It is, therefore,

ORDERED that Rule 40.1(b)(1) of the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure shall be, and the same hereby is reinstated; and it is, further,

ORDERED that Rule 21.1(a) of the Wyoming Rules of Criminal Procedure shall be, and the same hereby is, reinstated.
