Supreme Court Justice William U. Hill participated in a Liberty Day presentation to 70 fifth grade students at Davis Elementary on March 16th. The Liberty Day Institute is a nonprofit, nonpartisan, nationwide organization that provides materials designed to educate citizens, especially children, about the contents of the U.S. Constitution and its amendments. Each student received a pocket-sized booklet containing the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution, and teachers received lesson plan materials. Attorneys and judges across the state will be giving presentations during the month of March in nearly every fifth grade classroom in Wyoming. The program is being sponsored by the Wyoming State Bar and Equal Justice Wyoming.
